For more than two decades, The Honorable Aldona Woś, M.D. and Mr. Louis DeJoy have been extraordinary partners in the mission and growth of St. Pius X Catholic Parish. Their vision, generosity, and commitment to Catholic education have shaped our campus in profound and lasting ways. As lead benefactors of the DeJoy Primary Education Center, an anchor of our “Making a Place to Gather and Grow” campaign, their support helped bring to life a 22,885-square-foot, state-of-the-art facility dedicated to our youngest learners. Opened in 2016, the center provides an inspiring home for pre-kindergarten, kindergarten, and first-grade students, offering an environment intentionally designed to support early childhood development and to ensure a seamless, mission-driven transition through the elementary years.

Beyond this transformative contribution, the DeJoy-Wos Family Foundation has continued to invest deeply in the life of our parish. Their generosity was instrumental in the construction of the beautiful Cloister as part of the new St. Pius X Church dedicated in 2010, and they reaffirmed their commitment with an additional gift in 2021. Their longstanding philanthropy has continued even further, with notable leadership as a past Platinum Sponsor for the 70th Anniversary St. Pius X School Gala and significant continued support of the parish and school today.

Together, Dr. Woś and Mr. DeJoy have not only supported major capital projects, but have also embodied a genuine care for the future of Catholic education, parish life, and the flourishing of families in our community. Their leadership, philanthropy, and faithful presence have helped make St. Pius X a place where generations can learn, gather, and grow in Christ. Annual Fund

Sustaining Our Parish Today. Preparing for Tomorrow

The *Faith in Action Annual Fund* is a forward-looking initiative designed to strengthen the long-term vitality of St. Pius X. Unlike a traditional capital campaign focused on a single project, this fund is intentionally structured as an ongoing annual fund, allowing the parish the flexibility to respond prudently and responsibly to both current and future needs. This fund will build and maintain financial reserves that support the care, safety, and sustainability of our parish. These reserves will allow St. Pius X to address extraordinary needs beyond routine maintenance and enable thoughtful stewardship by ensuring resources are directed where they are most needed, when they are most needed, without being restricted to a single, narrowly defined purpose.

How the Fund Is Supported

The Faith in Action Annual Fund is sustained through a combination of generosity and participation, including:

- Event sponsorships
- The Inaugural *Faith in Action* Ball and future signature events
- Ongoing parish fundraising initiatives
- Individual and family contributions

Timeline and Path Forward

The initial phase of the Faith in Action Annual Fund will focus on raising a significant foundational level of support over a 1–2 year period. This initial effort allows the parish to begin building reserves while addressing prioritized needs identified through professional assessments and parish discernment. Following this foundational phase, the *Faith in Action Annual Fund* will continue as a permanent annual initiative, with a recurring yearly sponsorship and a push to sustain momentum, replenish reserves, and steadily prepare for future parish needs.

A Commitment to Faithful Stewardship

Through *Faith in Action*, St. Pius X is choosing a model rooted in flexibility, transparency, and long-term stewardship. It is one that honors the generosity of our parishioners while responsibly planning for the future. Together, we ensure that our parish remains strong, secure, and ready to serve for generations to come.

ASSESSMENT OF NEEDS: *Parish Rectory*

Clergy Residence: Providing a Dignified Home for Those Who Serve Our Parish

The current clergy residence of St. Pius X was built in the 1960s and no longer meets the needs of our growing parish or the diocesan standards for clergy housing. As a parish of increasing size and vitality, we are called to provide a safe, functional, and dignified living environment for our Priests, Parochial Vicars, and visiting clergy who serve our community so faithfully. Today, the rectory is both functionally outdated, has a failing foundation, and is in a state of disrepair, requiring significant investment to address safety, livability, and long-term suitability. After careful review, three responsible options have been identified to ensure proper housing for our clergy, now and into the future.

Option 1: Refurbish the Existing Rectory

A complete renovation of the current structure has been evaluated. The cost would be significant and the layout cannot be reconfigured to meet diocesan recommendations. For this reason, refurbishment is not an option at this time.

Option 2: Sell and Purchase a New Rectory

Selling the current rectory and purchasing a new residence is a strong economic option. While it may be difficult to find a home that fully meets all diocesan recommendations, it is likely we could secure a residence that comes close. The recommended layout includes private bedrooms and bathrooms for each resident, shared living and kitchen spaces, a study or chapel, and, if possible, accommodations for visiting priests and seminarians.

Estimated Investment: \$600,000

Option 3: Build a New Rectory

Constructing a new rectory offers the best long-term solution. This option allows St. Pius X to fully meet diocesan standards and design a residence that serves multiple clergy while providing hospitality for visiting priests and seminarians. While this option represents the highest investment, it best supports the future needs of our growing parish.

Estimated Investment: \$1,200,000

NAMING OPPORTUNITY AVAILABLE. All investment ranges are preliminary estimates, informed by professional input, and will be refined as formal assessments are completed and quotes are received.

ASSESSMENT OF NEEDS: *Facilities*



Caring for and Enhancing the Spaces Where Our Community Gathers

St. Pius X is blessed with a vibrant campus that supports worship, education, athletics, and fellowship. While current offertory and special donations are sufficient to address routine maintenance and ongoing small-scale repairs, several extraordinary facility needs are now on the horizon. These are projects that require additional planning, investment, and parish-wide support. These improvements are essential to maintaining our beautiful campus, preserving the quality, safety, and usefulness of our campus for both present and future generations.

School Roof Replacement

The roof of our school building has reached the end of its useful life and is in need of replacement. Addressing this need proactively will protect the school facility, prevent further damage, and ensure a safe and stable learning environment for our students, faculty, and parishioners that use the school facilities on a regular basis.

Estimated Investment: \$250,000

New School Playground

Our school aspires to build a new playground that reflects the high standards of our campus and complements the significant improvements already made, including:

- A new AstroTurf athletic field
- A beautiful outdoor pavilion
- A new school basketball court
- Upgraded pavilion surroundings with proper drainage and low-maintenance AstroTurf

Together, these projects have transformed this area of our campus into a functional, attractive, and welcoming space for our community. A new playground would complete this vision, providing a safe, engaging, and joyful environment for our youngest parish and school members.

Estimated Investment: \$225,000



ASSESSMENT OF NEEDS: *Security*

Protecting Our Children, Parishioners, and Community

The safety and well-being of our school children, parishioners, staff, and visitors is of paramount importance at St. Pius X. As our parish and campus continue to grow, so too does our responsibility to ensure that our facilities are secure, well-monitored, and prepared to respond effectively to potential risks. Our current campus infrastructure was designed for a different time and does not fully support the level of security and access control expected today. In response, St. Pius X has begun engaging professional security teams to conduct comprehensive assessments of our campus and vital campus-wide security updates, including the church building, parish center, school buildings, and gymnasium.

Security Assessments Underway

Professional security evaluations are currently in progress to identify vulnerabilities, recommend best-practice solutions, and help determine the most effective and responsible upgrades needed to enhance safety while maintaining a welcoming parish environment.

Anticipated Areas of Improvement

Based on preliminary findings, recommended upgrades are expected to include improvements in:

- Controlled access and movement throughout campus
- Visitor screening and monitoring
- Designated safe areas within buildings
- Perimeter fencing and campus boundaries
- Enhanced camera systems and surveillance coverage

These measures are intended to strengthen prevention, improve response capabilities, and provide peace of mind to families, parishioners, and staff.

Estimated Investment

As security assessments are finalized, more precise costs will be identified. Until that time, the parish is planning within an estimated investment range to ensure preparedness and responsible stewardship.

Estimated Investment: \$300,000 – \$700,000

ASSESSMENT OF NEEDS: *Ministries*



Serving Our Parish Family and Our Wider Community

St. Pius X is an active and engaged parish, offering more than 75 ministries dedicated to care, education, formation, and evangelization. Our parish school - the largest ministry of St. Pius X - forms young hearts and minds each day, serving as a cornerstone of our mission to Know, Love, and Serve the Lord. Through the generosity of our parishioners, our regular offertory, supplemented by event sponsorships, supports the majority of our ongoing ministry operations and daily needs. As we continue to care for our parish home and all who worship, learn, and serve here, we also recognize a growing call to deepen and expand our ministries in response to the needs emerging within our own parish family.

Responding to Urgent Human Needs

Among us are parishioners who face complex medical situations, aging-related challenges, or life-altering circumstances that leave them vulnerable and without clear advocacy. Senior citizens, families navigating serious illness, and individuals facing crisis often need guidance, coordination, and compassionate support within the community they already call home. St. Pius X is uniquely positioned to respond. We are blessed with parishioners whose professional expertise - whether in healthcare, education, finance, counseling, or administration - can be organized to form new ministries of advocacy and accompaniment rooted directly in our parish.

An Ongoing Faith in Action Commitment

Through the Faith in Action initiative, we seek first to care for and strengthen our parish home — ensuring that our campus, our school, and our ministries remain vibrant and sustainable. At the same time, we aim to thoughtfully develop new ministries that allow us to serve those among us who may not have a voice, living out the Gospel in tangible and practical ways. As needs arise within our parish family, Faith in Action provides a framework for responding with clarity, compassion, and stewardship.

Estimated Investment: Ongoing, as the St. Pius X community desires to pursue missions of mercy.


OUR FAITH

A Tradition of **GENEROSITY**

"The future is in your hearts and in your hands." St. John Paul II

Since acquiring its first 14.2-acre tract on Elm Street in 1954, St. PiusX has embodied the spirit of generosity and community service. Built initially as a mission of St. Benedict's, the school and chapel that opened in 1955 were erected through the sacrificial gifts and volunteer labor of early parishioners, setting a pattern of faithful giving that continues to define our mission today. From those humble beginnings, parish families laid the foundation, both literally and spiritually, for what would become a thriving, mission-driven community.



Visionary LEADERSHIP

Over subsequent decades, under visionary pastors, like Monsignor Anthony Marcaccio, St. Pius X parish undertook successive capital initiatives rooted in stewardship and forward planning. These included constructing a dedicated church building, parish center, athletic facilities, bell tower, and a columbarium - all thoughtfully financed without burdensome debt. Notably, the parish became the first in the diocesan foundation to reach \$1 million in endowments, demonstrating strategic generosity and fiscal stewardship made possible by parishioner-led giving and well-managed fundraising campaigns.



Generous STEWARDS

“Like living stones, let yourselves be built into a spiritual house...” 1 Peter 2:5

Major capital campaigns, such as “To Make a Place at the Table” and “Making a Place to Gather and Grow,” enabled the dedication of a new church and chapel in 2010 as well as the addition of the Simmons Parish Center, the DeJoy Early Primary Education Building, the Parr Family amphitheater, and playground enhancements. In 2023, the Lemnios Family Learning Pavilion was completed, and the Brady family’s “Peaceable Kingdom” sculpture was unveiled - a work of art designed and created by local artist and parishioner, Jim Galluci. Most recently, the Parr Family Athletic field was dedicated in 2024.

These are all evidence of our continued momentum toward growth and excellence. Through these efforts, we have strengthened both our spiritual life and campus infrastructure, always guided by a deep sense of welcoming and responsible stewardship.
