1. Call to order and opening prayer: Monsignor opened the meeting with a prayer at 7:05pm.
2. No minutes were available for review. Minutes will be distributed by Patricia Gillespie for review/approval at the next scheduled meeting.
3. Vision 2025 In-Progress Report: Elisabeth Rust re: Synod.
Elisabeth provided an update regarding the synodal gatherings and listening sessions. Currently, 23 adults and 11 teenagers have participated. Of the 11 teenagers, 10 were middle school students. There are 3 sessions remaining for parishioners that wish to participate. An invitation email was sent to parishioners in Liturgical Ministries for scheduled sessions. An announcement will also be included in an upcoming bulletin to reach any parishioner that wishes to contribute to this important call.
Elisabeth provided an overview of the process which included a brief introduction of what Pope Francis is calling us as the Church and baptized Christians to do and why. She also described this process as *prayerfully* listening to each other when responses to questions are discussed. The following questions were asked, and council members shared responses. Lindsay Sartorio was present and documented responses to the questions.
*What are the most significant signs of the Lord's presence in your life?
*What are the biggest challenges or questions you face in responding to the Lord's call?
*What steps are the Holy Spirit suggesting to you and your community to respond more fully to the Christian vocation?
4. New Business: Council members are asked to think about potential candidates for openings on the Parish Council. Lindsay stated an announcement and flyer will be placed in the bulletin for interested parishioners. An invitation for new members will be extended for the May meeting.
