Old Business:

Vision Document

Al provided a Facilities review, based on goals set forth in the Vision Document.

Campus beautification projects include repaving of the parking lot, improvements to playground equipment, improving the wall surrounding the dumpster, and adding stars from the DeJoy center to the church.

Facilities update: construction of a pavilion near the athletic center; in the approval process. Funds procured through donation.

Patricia provided a Stewardship review, based on goals set forth in the Vision Document.

October is Stewardship month. Guest speaker Sonja Corbett will be at SPX the weekend of September 23rd as a kickoff to Stewardship month. The third weekend of October will include highlights of ministries between mass times.

New Business:

Vision document review for September may include an adult from Lindsay regarding faith formation, nursery, and young adult ministry. Possible consideration of a subcommittee to prioritize components of the Vision documents.

Positive feedback regarding the nursery and there is notable, positive interest in adult volunteers for the children's liturgy.
