

Parish Council Meeting

February 28, 2023

Meeting started at 6:33 with prayer and call to order.

Patricia reviewed the previous meeting minutes; approved with no changes with motion offered by Paul and seconded by LaRonda.

Vision Statement Activities Update:

Shelley Kreber provided an update on the Senior Ministries activities:

There is lots of attendance at the various functions.

With the Seniors luncheon, the 8th graders from the school help serve the food and generally interact with the 70 or more seniors that attend. This provides an opportunity for positive interaction between the students and the seniors. Seniors 65 and older are invited. For many, this is a highly social event that is a highlight of their monthly calendar.

Seniors is a loose term, sometimes meaning over 65, but generally can be expanded to 55 and over.

Theology uncorked is a quarterly event for those typically 55 and over as a social event with a topical theological discussion. It provides an interesting perspective for later self-investigation and ponderance.

The Tai Chi is a class that is well attended for both the exercise and social interaction.

There needs to be some updates for the formal training manual for the Outreach for the sick and home bound.

Shelley helps Monsignor in his senior outreach activities when asked.

No longer organize weekly riders or general senior day trips.

Most of the activities are the result of senior feedback and suggestion

Old Business:

Greensboro Urban Ministry provided the number of 50,035 pounds of food provided last year. Saint Pius X provided approximately 5,185 pounds of Thanksgiving food; and miscellaneous food provided to other causes exceeded 2,000 pounds. These last numbers were approximate because of the weighing method but are accurate enough for these purposes.

New Business:

Patricia distributed the Appendix A of the Parish Bylaws dealing with the Nominating Committee. Dennis Bowie, Dan Jones and Bill Tyminski are on the Parish Council nomination committee, reviewing the new and previous volunteer forms for replacement member for fill the upcoming vacancies.

St Pius X should consider adding a (1) year term student member to the parish council for additional perspective. Matt Lopina may have positive input as to a rising 7th grade student which would be willing to serve. There had been student participation on the Parish Council in the past, maybe it is time to bring this back.

Emma suggested there is a service project available through Grimsley, a 5-piece ensemble.

The Boy and Cub Scouts are very active at St Pius X with many positive activities happening.

Pastor Report:

Jubilee planning is beginning.

Christy Holmes and Marth Harvey are taking over the First Friday Events.

In Echoes, Francine Britto's announcement will be coming out. There have been many positive comments.

There will be a Young Couples event soon.

The school will be evaluating the salaries to determine ways to minimize the differences between the public school and SPX.

Recent School related departures have generally not been salary related.

The School and Finance committee are investigating ways to properly improve the athletic field, east of the Connolly Athletic Center. It appears that an artificial turf system and field total rework will be needed which will add significant value to the grounds, reduce maintenance costs and improve the area storm water control.

A new covered shelter is being proposed for the area between the Connolly Athletic Center and the DeJoy Education center. It will go where a previous temporary tent structure was (destroyed by wind event). The previous tent was used often for alternative gathering sites for classes and events when the weather permitting. This will be built to complement the campus architecture and require minimal maintenance.

A new safety/privacy screen is being proposed for adjacent to the DeJoy Education Center. It will be artistic in nature, adding to the aesthetics of the campus while reducing a couple of safety concerns.

These last three items are potential capital sponsorship opportunities.

2. **Following Appointment** – Committee reviews duties and responsibilities, reviews timeline and establishes action plan to include:
 - a. Soliciting nominations as addressed in Article V of these Bylaws.
 - b. Review nominations from prior year(s).
3. **March**
 - a. Coordinate review of and placement of the Parish Pastoral Council Interest Form in the bulletin.
 - b. March Council meeting
 - i. Present nominations received to date.
 - ii. Receive nominations from the current Members.
4. **April**
 - a. April 1 – 14
 - i. Review all nominations.
 - ii. Provide an Executive Summary of the nomination process and provide the Pastor with the recommended slate of nominees.
 - b. April Council meeting
 - i. Pastor informs Council of the appointment of the new members based on the recommendation of the Committee.

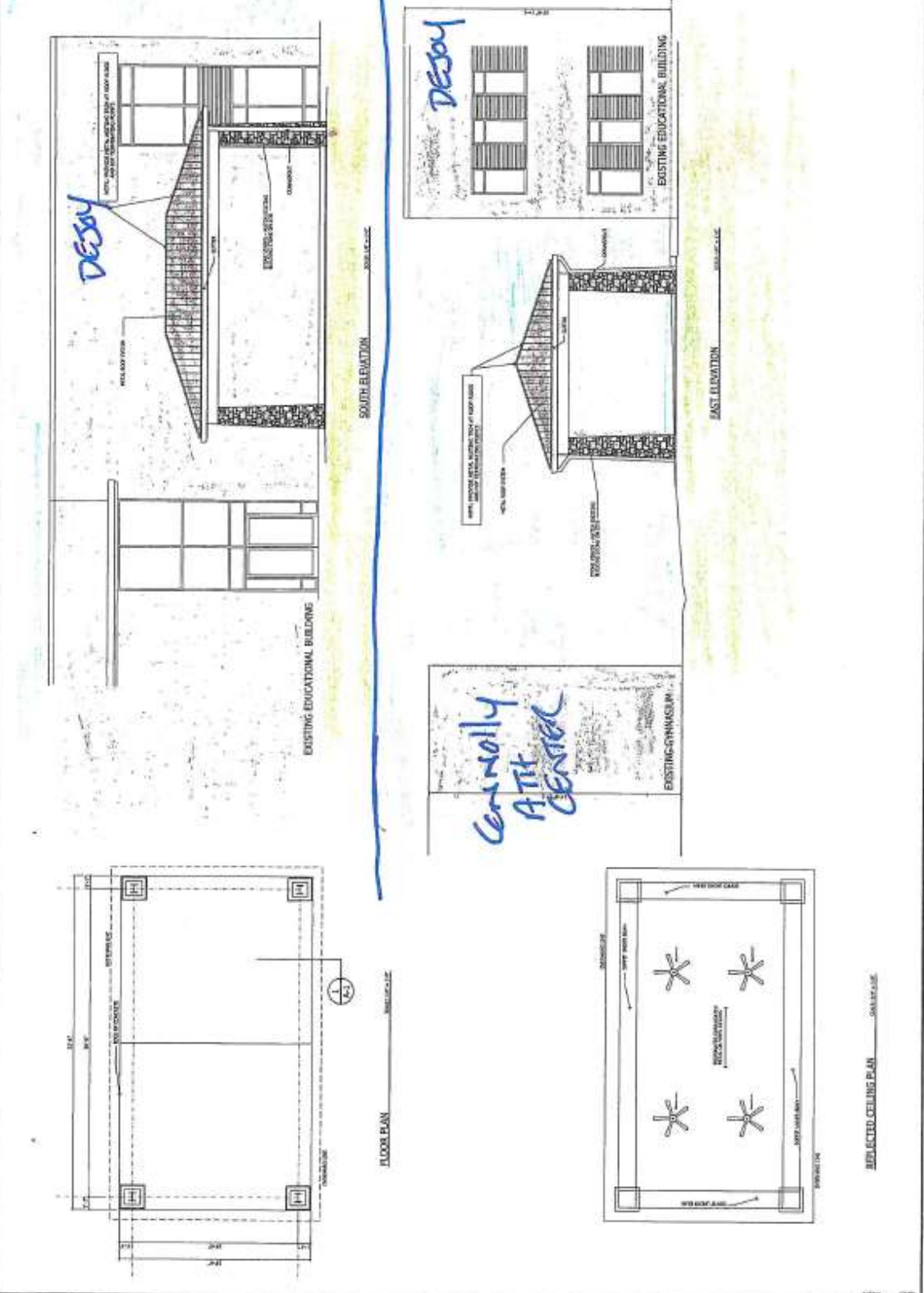
5. May

 - iii. Retiring Members final meeting.

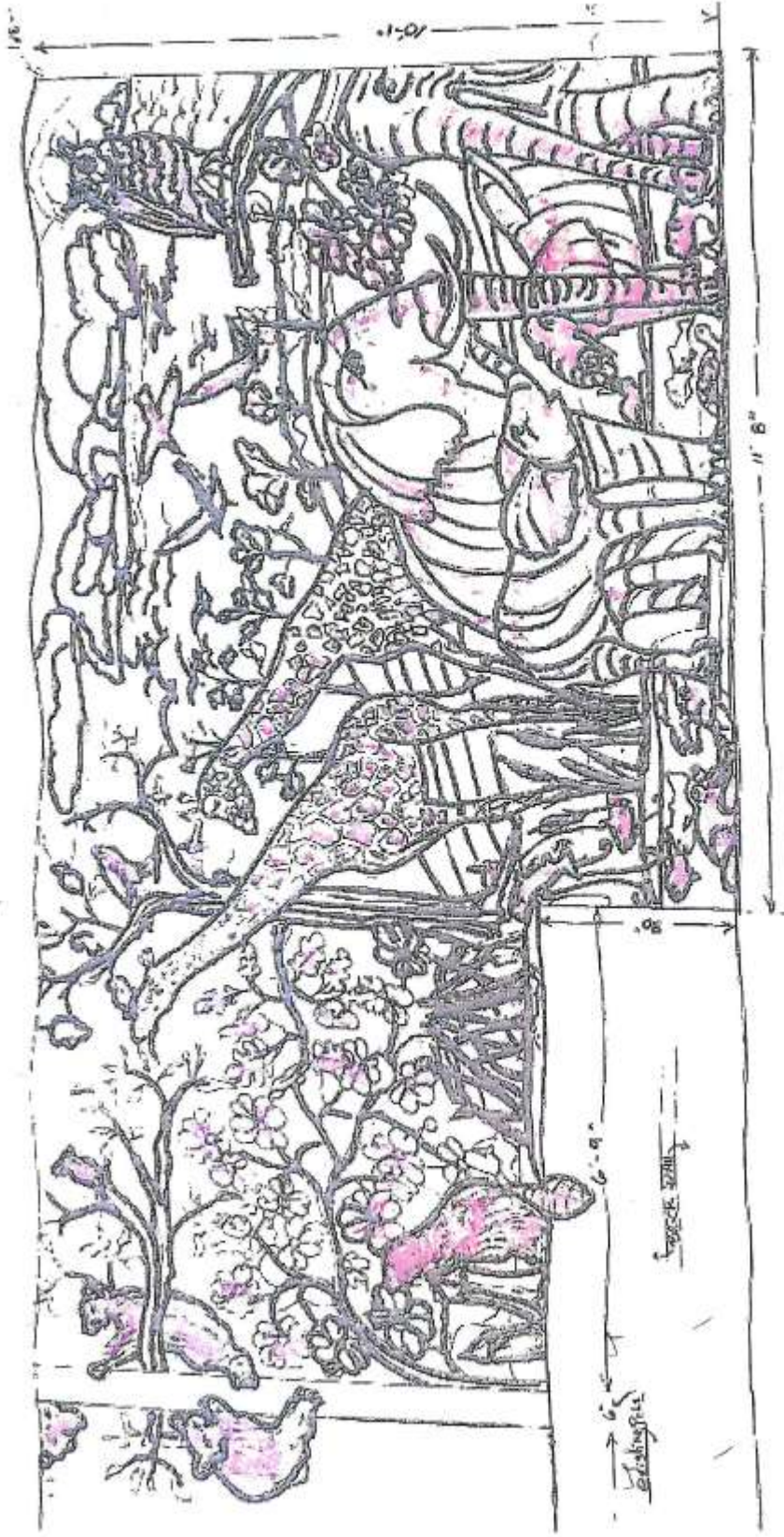
6. June
